

LEVEL 3 NVQ DIPLOMA IN OCCUPATIONAL WORK SUPERVISION



Introduction

This qualification has been developed for achievement in a real workplace environment which means learners will need to be employed to undertake this qualification. Learners will be assessed against a set of performance and knowledge statements which have been derived from National Occupational Standards. On completion, learners will be able to demonstrate that they have the practical competence required to work in the construction industry.

Structure

This qualification has six mandatory units and four optional units. To achieve this qualification a minimum of 67 credits needed to be attained from the mandatory group and 22 credits from the optional group.

Pre- requisite

This accreditation is available to anyone over the age of 18 who is capable of reaching the required standard. There are no barriers that restrict access or progression thereby promoting equal opportunity. It is expected however that learners will have a level of literacy adequate to cope with the assessment.

- Confirming work activities and resources for an occupational work area in the workplace
- Developing and maintaining good occupational working relationships in the workplace
- Confirming the occupational method of work in the workplace

- Co-ordinating and organising work operations in the workplace
- Monitoring progress of work against schedules in the workplace

Optional Units

- Allocating and monitoring the use of plant, machinery, equipment or vehicles in the workplace
- Confirming work meets contractual, industry and manufacturers' standards in the workplace
- Implementing procedures to support team performance in the workplace
- Co-ordinating and confirming the dimensional control requirements of the work in the workplace
